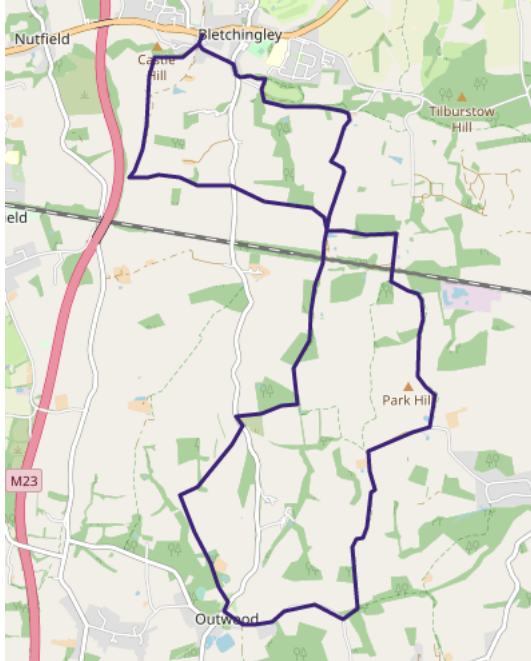


## Bletchingley and Outwood (11 miles)



An interesting and varied walk from Bletchingley to Outwood and back. As you walk along the Greensand Way and ancient cart tracks, look out for the private chapel attached to South Park Farm. On arrival in Outwood, the oldest working windmill in England is on the village common, although it is rarely open to the public. Outwood's 17<sup>th</sup> century pub, the Bell Inn, is just a short stroll from there. Back in Bletchingley after this 11-mile walk (nearly all flat, apart from the hill down from / back to the start point), try Lamingtons, a wonderful tea room.

Start point: Castle Square, Bletchingley. Park on the village streets.
