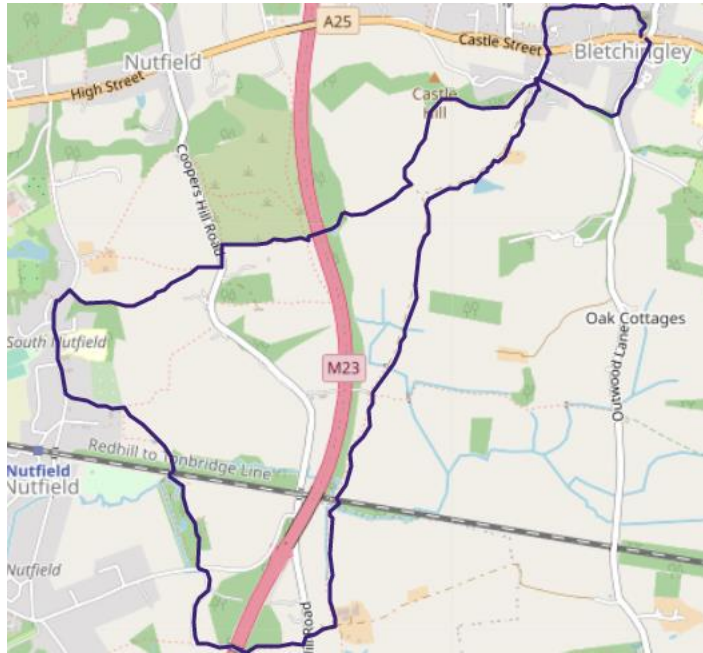


Bletchingley and South Nutfield Stroll (5 miles)



Starting in the historic village of Bletchingley, the walk goes past the site of the ruined mote and bailey castle on the hill, down to the village of South Nutfield and across level fields where cows and sheep graze peacefully. Although it crosses a motorway and a railway twice, this is a surprisingly beautiful and tranquil walk. Walkers may want to take a torch for the tunnel under the motorway. There are cafes, pubs and shops in both Bletchingley and South Nutfield for refreshment breaks.

Starting point: by the gate of the Norman Parish Church in Bletchingley. Parking is on the road in the village or on the green just before it.
