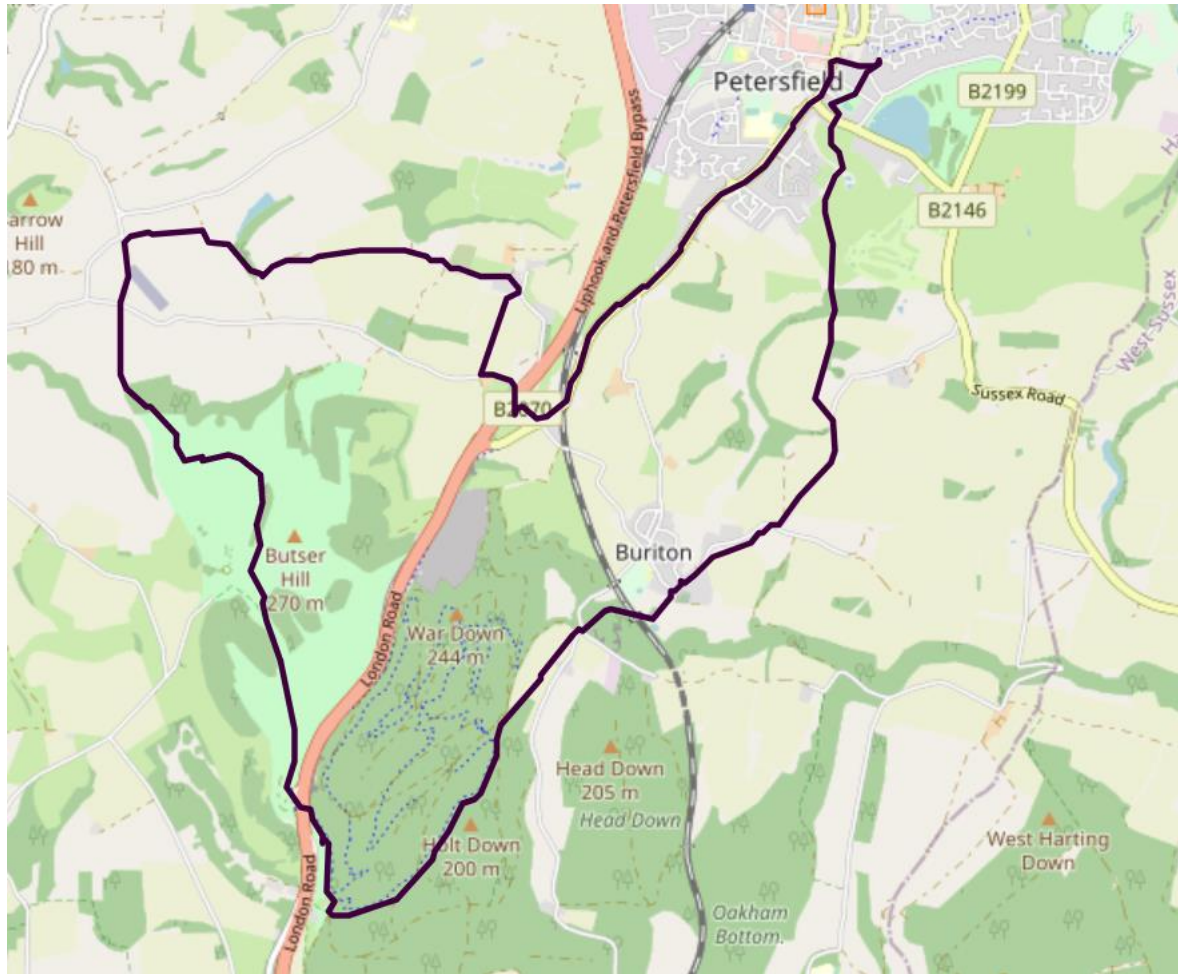


Buriton, Butser and Ramsdean (12 miles)



A walk through varying landscapes (meadows, woods, open fields, farmland). From Petersfield the walk goes to the picturesque village of Buriton and then climbs up along The Hangers Way to meet the South Downs Way. The route then follows the SDW to Queen Elizabeth Country Park and then up to the top of Butser Hill, the highest point in the South Downs, affording wonderful views to the Isle of Wight. The walk then descends down the quiet north side of Butser towards the village of Ramsdean and then continues along a mixture of farmland and an ancient sunken path to Weston and finally follows the B2070 road back into Petersfield.

The walk includes a couple of reasonably steep hills but is mostly downhill or flat after reaching the top of Butser. Total ascent about 1400 feet.

Starting point: Festival Hall car park, Heath Road, Petersfield
