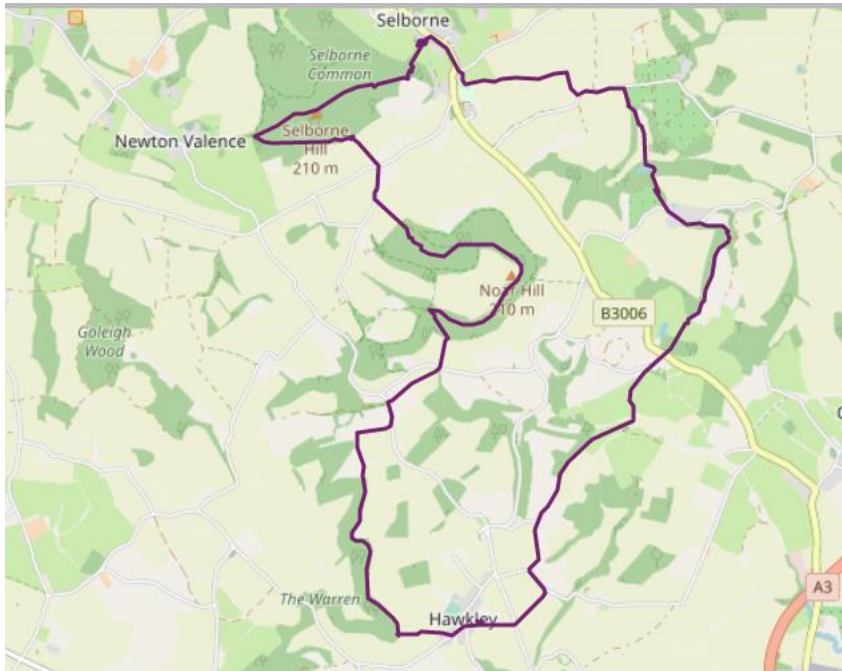


Selbourne Common, Noar Hill and the Hawkley Hangers (11 miles)



Walk Description: Starting from the Gilbert White Field Study Centre this walk climbs steeply up the White's Zig-Zag path with some great views to the East from the top. Heading across Selborne common to Noar Hill before descending along the Hangers Way to Hawkley (where you can find the Hawkley Inn), the route then skirts around the other side of Empshott before heading back to Selborne (and the Selborne Arms). This is a lovely walk at any time of year, but particularly nice in Spring when the valley meadows are full of flowers and the hedgerows are full of butterflies.

Terrain: 11 miles, hilly. Potential to be muddy and slippery in the wet.

Starting point: Car park behind the Selborne Arms pub off the B3006 High St. in Selborne, Hants.
Note that the field studies centre car park behind the pub car park is now chargeable.
